Camping during events is permitted in the Clay Street Parking Lot (except as noted on the map). During Import & Performance and GM Nationals, camping is located on the Carlisle Fairgrounds. (No camping at Truck Nationals.) Reservations may be made in advance by registered showfield participants and vendors. Others must visit the Registration Building outside Gate 3 during an event. Two bathhouses are available on the Carlisle Fairgrounds.

Do:

- Wear comfortable shoes

- Bring a cart or wagon to transport items you purchase in the flea market

Don't:



- No glass containers/bottles

PARKING & CAMPING

Carlisle Events manages car, trailer and camper parking in the lots shown in yellow.

Gate 5 Parking Lot - enter from Cavalry Road at the "Gate 5" sign.

Gate 4 Parking Lot - pre-purchased admission & parking package required, no "drive-ups", enter from K Street, staff at Gate 3 will direct.

Carlisle Events Parking Lot - cars (general parking) enter from Clay Street, trailers and campers enter at 119 Carlisle Springs Road near E Street.

Many neighboring residents offer parking on their properties. They set their own fees.
